

# USWOA Clinician Responsibilities:

## Pre Tournament:

1. Make contact with Tournament Director.
2. Determine the availability of a room, VCR/TV and chalkboard for mat official's clinic.
3. Make arrangements to be at the tournament site before the tournament begins and you are responsible to remain at the site until the tournament has been completed.
4. All Tournament Site information is on the USA Wrestling Web Page at:

Check on tournament schedule for clinic time and site.

5. Make contact with various state mat official directors surrounding the tournament site to encourage officials of the opportunity to officiate, and to be recommended for upgrade. Inform local officials of the potential of upgrade.
6. Recruit the top officials in the area for the tournament.
7. Make contact with National Rules Interpreter for any new rules interpretation:

## Tournament Site:

1. Set up and determine the level of clinic or clinics to be given. Be sure to monitor the sign-in sheet.
2. Conduct all official clinics, pre - during - post competition.
3. Circulate sign-in sheet and collect license books.
4. You must be sure you work closely with the Head Official, Chief Pairer, and the Tournament Director.
5. Do not take over as the Head Official but help him/her do the responsibilities.

## Post Tournament:

1. Submit in writing all major problems with rule interpretation to USWOA Administrative Assistant or USWOA President Rick Tucci within 10 days.
2. This is extremely important as you will not have future assignments if you do not return the information within 10 Days from the completion of the Competition.
